

Bare Boat Charter Contract

Agreement between owner of vessel (Owner) and Person who is chartering the vessel (Charterer).

1. Owner is agreeing to allow charterer use of this vessel. The agreed charter duration shall begin: Date: _____ Time _____ and the charterer must return vessel no later than Date: _____ Time _____
2. Charterer agrees to maintain the vessel how it is received by them and will be responsible for any damages made by them on the vessel during their time of charter.
3. Owner agrees that the vessel is maintained and kept in suitable condition required for safe operation in Intracoastal waters. Charterer and Captain shall inspect the vessel to verify this prior to launch. Any complaint or deficiency about the vessel's safety equipment or seaworthiness shall be addressed and settled before charterer takes possession of the vessel.
4. Charterer and Captain agree that this vessel is for intracoastal use only and never allowed in the open waters of the ocean.
5. Charterer must be aboard the vessel at all time. He/She may not allow the boat to be underway without being aboard the vessel.
6. Charterer is not obligated to carry insurance for the vessel however will be required to leave a deposit upon owner's request. If required, fill out the deposit information below.

7. Charterer agrees that the renting of this vessel is solely for pleasure purposes and that no illegal or dangerous activities shall be performed by the charterer himself, others with him or his employees.
8. Charterer is responsible for any dockage charges or any fees accrued during their usage of the vessel. Charterer will provide their own food, drinks and stores for their charter.
9. This vessel shall not be subcontracted out by the charterer as it is for his own pleasure purposes only.
10. A captain must be hired by the charterer directly. This person must be experienced in operating a vessel in south Florida Intracoastal waters.
11. Charterer is responsible for paying the captain or any crew.
12. The charterer has the right to discharge, for cause, the captain or crew of the vessel without deferment to the owner.
13. Owner agrees that all safety components required by law are on board and kept in good working order. Captain confirms this as well.
